ELicensing Services Expand to Include Online Exam & Exam/License Applications

Sacramento – The Department of Real Estate (DRE) is pleased to announce that beginning September 1, 2021, applicants for the exam and exam/license can apply online via DRE's website through <u>eLicensing</u>.

You can access the Online Exam License Application system either by signing in to your existing eLicensing account or by creating a new one if you don't already have an account. The system guides users through the exam or exam/license application, and includes a page to upload any required documents/forms and a page to pay the required fees.

<u>This short video</u> reviews the documents and forms you'll need, depending on the type of application you plan to submit.

Submitting your application online will allow you to check the progress of your application, and to receive email notifications if DRE needs any additional information as well as when your application is complete.

ELicensing is secure, easy to use, and available 24/7. In addition to submitting applications, you can use this convenient online service to schedule an exam, renew your license, print a license certificate, and make changes to an existing license, including an address change, updating a salesperson affiliation, and submitting a broker associate notification.

Providing the option to submit applications electronically, along with other eLicensing functions, is part of DRE's ongoing commitment to improve its services for licensees.
