NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the provisions of Sections 3000(a)(3) and (8) and 3003 of Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations (herein "the Regulations") that the Real Estate Commissioner (herein "the Commissioner") has caused an investigation to be made into the presentation of the continuing education course offerings identified in Paragraph 2, below. Said course offerings are sponsored by SIERRA SEMINARS (herein "SIERRA") and were previously approved by the Department of Real Estate which has now become the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of California (herein "the Bureau") and on the basis of said investigation, the Commissioner has determined that said courses no longer meet the statutory and regulatory standards for approval for continuing education course offerings, and that approval of said courses should be and hereby are withdrawn for the reasons set forth below:

- 1. SIERRA is the sponsor, BRE Sponsor #S0231, of the continuing education course offerings identified in Paragraph 2, below. SIERRA is owned and/or controlled by Wallace Gifford Cooke (herein "Cooke"); Cooke is the only instructor for SIERRA.
- 2. The Bureau issued to SIERRA, approval for the following continuing education course offerings pursuant to Section 10170.4 of the California Business and Professions Code (herein "the Code") and Sections 3006 through 3009 of the Regulations:

- 4. Effective about February 18, 2004, Respondent Cooke's real estate broker license (00401584) was revoked with right to a restricted *salesperson* license (in the Bureau's Case No. H-3806 SAC).
