

The Commissioner ("Commissioner") of the California Department of Real Estate ("Department") caused an investigation to be made of the activities of NATIONWIDE HOME ASSISTANCE ("NATIONWIDE"), JAMES RADOGNA ("RADOGNA"), DAVID DUARTE ("DUARTE"), YVONNE ENCINAS ("ENCINAS") and COLONEL KULEE ("KULEE"). Based on that investigation, the Commissioner has determined that NATIONWIDE, RADOGNA, DUARTE, ENCINAS and KULEE have engaged in or are engaging in acts or are attempting to engage in the business of, acting in the capacity of, and/or advertising or assuming to act as real estate brokers in the State of California within the meaning of Business and Professions Code ("Code") Section 10131(d) (soliciting, negotiating and performing services for borrowers in connection with loans secured by real property).

In addition, based on that investigation, the Commissioner has determined that

NATIONWIDE, RADOGNA, DUARTE, ENCINAS and KULEE have engaged in or are 1 engaging in acts or are attempting to engage practices constituting violations of the California 2 Business and Professions Code ("Code") and/or Title 10, California Code of Regulations 3 ("Regulations"). Based on the findings of that investigation, set forth below, the Commissioner 4 hereby issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Desist and Refrain Order 5

under the authority of Section 10086 of the Code. Whenever acts of NATIONWIDE are referred to below, those acts are alleged to 7

conspirators.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. NATIONWIDE is not now, and has never been, licensed by the Department in any capacity.

- 2. RADOGNA is not now, and has never been, licensed by the Department in any capacity.
- 3. DUARTE is not now, and has never been, licensed by the Department in any capacity.
- 4. ENCINAS is not now, and has never been, licensed by the Department in any capacity.
- 5. KULEE is not now, and has never been, licensed by the Department in any capacity.
- 6. At the time set forth below each and every respondent solicited borrowers and negotiated to do one or more of the following acts for another or others, for or in expectation of compensation: engaged in the business of, acted in the capacity of, or advertised a loan solicitation, negotiation and/or modification service using the name Nationwide Home Assistance wherein Respondents were soliciting, offering to negotiate or perform loan modification services with respect to loans which were secured by liens on real property for compensation or in expectation of compensation and for fees collected in advance of the

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transaction.

Emil Jaska's transaction

- 7. In approximately January 2009, NATIONWIDE, by and through RADOGNA, solicited Emil Jaska (Jaska) in order to provide loan modification services to save Jaska's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- 8. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Jaska, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Jaska. In reliance on NATIONWIDE''S representations, Jaska paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about January 29, 2009.
- 9. After Jaska paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Filberto Botello's transaction

- 10. In approximately January 2009, NATIONWIDE solicited Filberto Botello (Botello) in order to provide loan modification services to save Botello's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- 11. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Botello, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,498 from Botello. In reliance on NATIONWIDE'S representations, Botello paid NATIONWIDE \$2,498 on or about January 29, 2009.
- 12. After Botello paid the \$2,498 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Akmal Khan's transaction

13. In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE, by and through COLONEL KULEE solicited Akmal Khan (Khan) in order to provide loan modification services to save Khan's home from being lost in foreclosure.

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In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan 14. modification services to Khan, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Khan. In reliance on NATIONWIDE"S representations, Khan paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about December 31, 2008.

After Khan paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he 15. received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Matt Okdemir's transaction

- In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Matt Okdemir 16. (Okdemir) in order to provide loan modification services to save Okdemir's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan 17. modification services to Okdemir, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,499 from Okdemir. In reliance on NATIONWIDE"S representations, Okdemir paid NATIONWIDE \$2,499 on or about December 11, 2008.
- After Okdemir paid the \$2,499 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he 18. received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Gregory Cheever's transaction

- In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Gregory 19. Cheever (Cheever) in order to provide loan modification services to save Cheever 's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan 20. modification services to Cheever, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Cheever. In reliance on NATIONWIDE''S representations, Cheever paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about December 15, 2008.

After Cheever paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he 21. 1 received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone 2 connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance. 3 Arthur Darden's transaction 4 In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Arthur Darden 5 22. (Darden) in order to provide loan modification services to save Darden 's home from being lost in 6 7 foreclosure. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan 23. 8 modification services to Darden, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,500 from 9 Darden. In reliance on NATIONWIDE"'S representations, Darden paid NATIONWIDE \$2,500 10 on or about December 18, 2008. 11 After Darden paid the \$2,500 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he 12 24. received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone 13 connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Frank Williams' transaction

- In approximately February 2009, NATIONWIDE solicited Frank Williams 25. (Williams) in order to provide loan modification services to save Williams' home from being lost in foreclosure.
- In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan 26. modification services to Williams, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Williams. In reliance on NATIONWIDE"S representations, Williams paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about March 9, 2009.
- After Williams paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he 27. received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

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Michael Russell's transaction

- 28. In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Michael Russell (Russell) in order to provide loan modification services to save Russell's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- 29. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Russell, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,695 from Russell. In reliance on NATIONWIDE'S representations, Russell paid NATIONWIDE \$2,695 on or about December 16, 2008.
- 30. After Russell paid the \$2,695 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Rueben Hoffman's transaction

- 31. In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Rueben Hoffman (Hoffman) in order to provide loan modification services to save Hoffman's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- 32. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Hoffman, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Hoffman. In reliance on NATIONWIDE''S representations, Hoffman paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about December 19, 2008.
- 33. After Hoffman paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Richard Kuhn's transaction

34. In approximately November 2008, NATIONWIDE, by and through ENCINAS, solicited Richard Kuhn (Kuhn) in order to provide loan modification services to save Kuhn's home from being lost in foreclosure.

- 35. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Kuhn, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Kuhn. In reliance on NATIONWIDE''S representations, Kuhn paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about November 18, 2008.
- 36. After Kuhn paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

Mark Nagle's transaction

- 37. In approximately November 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Mark Nagle (Nagle) in order to provide loan modification services to save Nagle's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- 38. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Nagle, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,999 from Nagle. In reliance on NATIONWIDE'S representations, Nagle paid NATIONWIDE \$2,999 on or about November 18, 2008.
- 39. After Nagle paid the \$2,999 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

James Powell's transaction

- 40. In approximately February 2009, NATIONWIDE, by and through DUARTE, solicited James Powell (Powell) in order to provide loan modification services to save Powell's rental homes from being lost in foreclosure.
- 41. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Powell, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$7,497 from Powell. In reliance on NATIONWIDE'S representations, Powell paid NATIONWIDE \$7,497 on or about February 13, 2009.

42. After Powell paid the \$7,497 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, he received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

- 43. In approximately December 2008, NATIONWIDE solicited Shala Owhady (Owhady) in order to provide loan modification services to save Owhady's home from being lost in foreclosure.
- 44. In furtherance of NATIONWIDE'S plan and scheme to provide loan modification services to Owhady, NATIONWIDE requested an advance fee of \$2,499 from Owhady. In reliance on NATIONWIDE'S representations, Owhady paid NATIONWIDE \$2,499 in or about December 2008.
- 45. After Owhady paid the \$2,499 mentioned above to NATIONWIDE, she received no further communications or services of any type from NATIONWIDE or from anyone connected in any way with Nationwide Home Assistance.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

46. Based on the information contained in Paragraphs 1 through 45, above, NATIONWIDE, RADOGNA, DUARTE, ENCINAS and KULEE violated Section 10130 of the Code by engaging in the activities without first obtaining a broker license from the Department.

DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER

Based upon the FINDINGS OF FACT and CONCLUSIONS OF LAW stated herein, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

A. NATIONWIDE HOME ASSISTANCE, JAMES RADOGNA, DAVID DUARTE, YVONNE ENCINAS and COLONEL KULEE, immediately desist and refrain from performing any acts within the State of California for which a real estate broker license is required, unless or until you are so licensed.

In particular each of them is ordered to desist and refrain from:

- 1. charging, demanding, claiming, collecting and/or receiving advance fees, as that term is defined in Section 10026 of the Code, in any form, and under any conditions, with respect to the performance of loan modifications or any other form of mortgage loan forbearance service in connection with loans on residential property containing four or fewer dwelling units (Code Section 10085.6); and
- 2. charging, demanding, claiming, collecting and/or receiving advance fees, as that term is defined in Section 10026 of the Code, for any other real estate related services offered by them to others.

Notice: Business and Professions Code Section 10139 provides that "Any person acting as a real estate broker or real estate salesperson without a license or who advertises using words indicating that he or she is a real estate broker without being so licensed shall be guilty of a public offense punishable by a fine not exceeding twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed six months, or by both fine and imprisonment; or if a corporation, be punished by a fine not exceeding sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000)."
